Most people have noticed the Lions Club's yellow and blue painted recycled U.S. mailboxes that are scattered around Pennsylvania and New Jersey. And many of those folks have thoughtfully dropped their used eyeglasses into one of them to be recycled.

All types of used eyeglasses and sunglasses, prescription and nonprescription, for children and adults are accepted, including exceptionally strong or weak prescriptions. Reading glasses are also useful for those who perform close-up tasks while at work. Sunglasses are needed for people living near the equator, especially those with cataracts.

At our annual District 14A Conference we collect eyeglasses from all clubs in the District for shipment to the New Jersey Lions Eyeglass Recycling Center in West Trenton, N.J.
