# Lions Scholarship Criteria For Physically Challenged High School Seniors 2023-2024 Academic Year (Class of 2024)

The Lions District 14A Charitable Foundation was established as an IRS 501(c)3 charity with the mission to help improve the quality of life of the blind, vision or hearing impaired and physically handicapped in the Bucks, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia Counties.

In keeping with our mission, we are offering a limited number of \$1000 scholarships to vision, hearing and physically challenged high school seniors in the 4-County area to attend an accredited post-secondary institution. There is no required course of study for the scholarships.

Financial need, academic achievement, participation in activities and achievements, in addition to a disability will be elements of the scholarship selection criteria. Scholarship payment will be made directly to the awardees selected institute of learning. Awards will take place at the high school graduation or awards ceremony.

# GUIDELINES FOR VISION, HEARING AND PHYSICAL IMPAIRMENT

Our guidelines for scholarship eligibility are based on, but not solely, definitions from the ADA and various State Agencies and are broad in scope to allow easier evaluation for eligibility by the school staff.

<u>Vision:</u> Visual impairment including blindness is impairment in vision that, even with correction, adversely affects a student's educational performance. The term includes both partial sight and blindness.

<u>Hearing:</u> Hearing impairment will be defined as a significant functional limitation from hearing loss, i.e., documented hearing loss of 20db or greater in the better ear.

**Physical:** A physical impairment which has a substantial and long-term effect on the student's ability to carry out day to day activities of walking and communicating.
